Brittnee's training includes the Skaters High Achievement Readiness Program in Kingston with Lloyd Eisler, The Minto Skating Club in Ottawa, New Jersey with Isabelle Brassuer, as well as a number of EOS training camps and seminars with Olympic and National skaters and coaches. Her experience also includes competing at a number of competitive competitions across the country. Brittnee has completed her CanSkate and Star Skate Level 1 training. She is very excited to share her passion and expertise with the students of the Gananoque Skating Club.

Adam placed 3rd at Nationals in 2007 and competed on the Junior Grand Prix Circuit for 4 years with a Bronze in Belarus and a Gold in Lake Placid both in 2009. This led to his advancing to the Junior Grand Prix final with a 5th place finish and a 10th place finish at Junior Worlds in the 2009/2010 season. This past year he competed in the Cup of China on the Senior Grand Prix Circuit. Nationally, he has competed at the Senior level for the past 3 years and placed 5th at Nationals and was named to the National Team. Adam has also managed to gain experience as a coach in Western Ontario for the past 3 years. He has lead Can Skate sessions, group lessons, stroking classes, off-Ice fitness for all ages, and harness lessons. Adam is a big believer in the importance of off-ice conditioning and nutrition and the benefits it provides on-ice!
